Code of Conduct

Inverleigh Bows Club Code of Conduct

Every person in Victoria has the right to participate in community sport which is safe, welcoming and inclusive. Equally everyone plays a part in ensuring their actions and behaviours are supportive of these values.

The Code provides the opportunity to make a positive impact on community participation in sport and recreation by encouraging appropriate behaviour at all times. Implementation of the Code will ensure that community sport remains safe and inclusive for all.

Inverleigh Bows Club, under the leadership of the Victorian Code of Conduct for community sport and Bows Victoria has adopted the following Code of Conduct:

Every member of the Inverleigh Bows Club should:

- Ensure inclusion of every person regardless of their age, gender or sexual orientation, culture or religion.
- Provide opportunities for people of all abilities to participate in the sport and develop to their full potential.
- Show respect towards members, guests, the club, the facility and the broader community by using language that is not offensive, abusive or threatening.
- Provide a safe and inclusive environment for guests, members and the broader community through the elimination of violent, abusive or threatening behaviour.
- Protect all members from sexual harassment or intimidation.

This Code applies to all members during competition, training, social days and club sanctioned activities. Non-adherence to the code will result in the individual facing disciplinary action.
